CLYDE 3 MILE LIMIT (PROPOSAL)

Scottish Creelers and Divers (SCAD), Ayrshire and Clyde Static Gear Fisherman's Association (ACSGFA), Community of Arran Seabed Trust (COAST) Scottish Sub-aqua Club (SSAC) and numerous Clyde based community councils with other interested parties wish to submit the proposal as set out below.

PROPOSAL

It is proposed that due to the poor ecological status of the Clyde, the Cabinet Secretary, Richard Lochhead, uses his powers to amend fishing vessel licences in order that all methods of mobile, bottom trawling and dredging are prohibited from the area within 3 miles of the Clyde shoreline.

Whether you are a member of a sea angling organisation, an individual angler, a diver, or a member of the general public, we ask that you sign our petition which will be handed over to the Scottish Parliament or Richard Lochhead Cabinet Secretary responsible for marine environment & fisheries in the near future.
